<p>Mixed Bottles & Cans</p> <p>Put these bottles, cans and jars together in a reusable container with a lid and handles.</p> <p>Rinse all bottles and cans; Put plastic caps and lids into trash; Do not put recyclable cans & bottles into plastic or paper bags</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Aluminum Cans 	Be sure to rinse	No foil or pie plates
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Glass bottles & jars 	Remove lids; place plastic lids in trash; place metal lids into recycling bin; rinse the bottles and jars	No drinking glasses, mirrors, light bulbs, ceramic, window glass or Pyrex
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plastic bottles coded 	Remove lids and place them in the trash; rinse bottles	No buckets, toys, plastic bags, margarine or cottage cheese tubs, yogurt cups, frozen dinner trays or deli containers
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Steel (tin) cans 	Rinse	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Paint & aerosol cans 	Metal paint cans must be empty, dry and open with lids removed; Aerosol cans must be empty with plastic nozzles removed

<p>Mixed Paper</p> <p>Put these types of mixed paper together in a reusable container with a lid and handles.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Newspaper 	NEW FOR 2008 – Newspaper no longer needs to be tied	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Magazines, catalogs, coupons 	Include non-foil/non-metallic gift wrap and carbonless paper	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Junk mail & envelopes 		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Office paper 	Include computer and copy paper and manila folders	No metal clips or carbon paper
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Soft-cover books 	Include soft-cover workbooks, paperback books, phone books and books with hard covers removed (put hard covers in trash)	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Chipboard and boxboard 	Include cereal and pasta boxes, gift boxes, notebook backings, egg cartons, cores from paper towels	No metallic coating of any kind, no beer or soda six/twelve pack holders, frozen food packaging, gable-to[milk/juice cartons, juice boxes
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Corrugated cartons 	Empty and flatten corrugated cardboard boxes and put into container with all other mixed paper; If the cardboard does not fit into the container, <u>flatten, cross-tie or stack in one small box and place next to container</u>	No Styrofoam, peanuts, blocks or plastic bags. Place these items in the trash
