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# **DISCUSSION**

<u>Tree Ordinance</u>: Based on the discussion at the December 9, 2012 regular meeting of the Board, Chair Kraft and Ms. Callahan had provided the following draft letter to the Board for review:

TO: Mayor and Borough Council

FROM: Mendham Borough Planning Board

**DATE:** January 15, 2013

REFERENCE: TREE CONSERVATION

The December 10 meeting of the Planning Board was devoted entirely to a discussion of whether or not to recommend a tree ordinance that would regulate the cutting of trees on private property. In general the Board came to the conclusion that regulating trees on private property is difficult and likely to be expensive. There was also a concern that the Borough could face potential liability if a tree cutting permit were denied, and subsequently that tree fell and caused damage and/or injury.

The Board universally feels that a proactive education program should be established. It is recommended that the program start with the elementary schools and be coupled with

web site and newsletter articles that advocate for the saving of existing trees and the planting of new trees.

The final conclusion is that there will be no recommendation for a tree ordinance, but rather the Board is requesting that the Borough Council consider implementing the following:

- 1. The Borough Council establish and fund an annual Arbor Day program at the elementary school level that educates as to the value of trees and strongly promotes the preservation of trees on private property as well as the planting of new and replacement trees on private property
- 2. The Borough web site have a prominent article developed jointly with the Shade Tree Commission and the Environmental Commission that offers free advice on the selection of and proper placement of trees on private property
- 3. The Mendham Messenger have regular articles on tree preservation and opportunities for the purchase and planting of trees on private property
- 4. The Shade Tree Commission and the Environmental Commission develop a program that will offer to Borough residents a selection of trees for purchase that are suitable for planting on residential lots in this region and assistance in planting those trees.
- 5. The Borough enhance its current tree replacement program with additional annual tree planting and explore with property owners the potential placement of trees along the streetscape where the right of way does not support their growth.
- 6. The Shade Tree Commission undertake a study of Borough trees of significant historic value that should be preserved and maintained at a high level.
- 7. The Borough actively pursue any grants related to the purchase, planting and/or education dealing with trees.
- 8. That these programs be established with continuing funding to insure that residents know the value of trees, understand what trees are best suited to Mendham properties and have opportunities to purchase in the context of an established Borough program.

Councilman Sharkey stated that the letter was a positive step. He recommended that the size of the Shade Tree Commission be increased so that the awareness of trees can be increased. Board questioned whether the Shade Tree Commission and the Environmental Commission could be combined. Ms. Sandman stated that the Shade Tree Commission was kept small until the work required was determined. She is looking toward Arbor Day and joint effort with the Environmental Commission.

Mr. Cascais made a motion to approve the letter for forwarding to the Borough Council. Councilman Sharkey seconded. All members being in favor the motion carried. Ms. Callahan will send the letter to the Borough Council.

# OTHER BUSINESS

<u>National Register</u>: Ms. Callahan reported that there will be a public meeting held by the State Department of Historic Preservation at the Garabrant Center on Thursday, February 21 at 7:30 p.m. At that time the State will make a presentation and address any resident questions. The Borough's application will be on the agenda for the State Historic Preservation Review Board on March 12.

#### **ADJOURNMENT**

There being no additional business to come before the Board, on motion made, seconded and carried, Chair Kraft adjourned the meeting at 8:25 p.m. The next regularly scheduled meeting of the Planning Board will be held on **Monday, February 11, 2013 at 8:00 p.m.** at the Garabrant Center, 4 Wilson St., Mendham.
