RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING TO PAULUS, SOKOLOWSKI & SARTOR, LLC FOR GPS SURVEY COORDINATION AND DATA PROCESSING FOR THE WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mendham has a need to acquire professional Global Positioning System ("GPS") Survey Coordination and Data Processing services without competitive bidding pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated term of this contract is twelve (12) months; and

WHEREAS, Paulus, Sokolowski & Sartor, LLC has submitted a proposal indicating that it will provide GPS Survey Coordination and Data Processing services in an amount not to exceed \$9,805.00; and

WHEREAS, Paulus, Sokolowski & Sartor, LLC has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that Paulus, Sokolowski & Sartor, LLC has not made any reportable contributions to any candidate committee in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit Paulus, Sokolowski & Sartor, LLC from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the service was approved as part of Ordinance #06-2022 for Sewer General Capital Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mendham desire to award the contract to Paulus, Sokolowski & Sartor, LLC; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) requires that the Resolution authorizing the award of contracts for "professional services" without competitive bids and the contract itself must be available for public inspection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mendham as follows:

1. The Borough Council hereby awards and authorizes the Mayor and Borough Clerk to execute an agreement with Paulus, Sokolowski & Sartor, LLC of Warren, New Jersey for Global Positioning System ("GPS") Survey Coordination and Data Processing services for the twelve (12) month period.

- 2. This contract is awarded without competitive bidding as a "professional service" in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a) of the Local Public Contracts Law because said services are exempt from the provisions of the bidding statutes in that they are services rendered or performed by a person authorized by law to practice a recognized profession and are services which require knowledge of an advanced type in a field of learning acquired by a prolonged course of specialized instruction as distinguished from general academic instruction or apprenticeship and training.
- 3. The Business Entity Disclosure Certification, and the Determination of Value shall be placed on file with this resolution.
- 4. This Resolution is subject to the Chief Financial Officer certifying to the availability of funds in the amount as set forth in N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.5.
- 5. A Notice of this action shall be published once in the official newspaper as required by law.

RESOLUTION REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS NEW JERSEY INFRASTRUCTURE BANK PROJECT# S340159-04

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2023, the Borough of Mendham solicited bids for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements New Jersey Infrastructure Bank Project# S340159-04 & Borough Ordinance #11-2019, Bond Ordinance Providing for Improvements of the Sewerage System; and

WHEREAS, although 16 sets of contract documents were purchased by potential bidders, only two sealed bids were received and opened on August 10, 2023, in accordance with the advertised date for acceptance of bids; and

WHEREAS, the bids received were in the amounts of \$4,214,000.00 (CMS Construction) and \$4,853,200.00 (Rapid Pump and Meter Company) and significantly over budget; and

WHEREAS, based on the high cost and the low bid turnout, the Borough has determined that the specifications should be revised to modify the scope of work and rebid; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2a and 40A:11-13.2d of the Local Public Contracts Law authorizes a municipality to reject all bids where the lowest bid substantially exceeds the cost estimates for the goods or services and where the contracting unit wants to substantially revise the specifications for the goods or services, respectively.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mendham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey that all bids received for the Water Reclamation Facility Project are hereby rejected for the reasons stated in this Resolution.
