NJ Hope & Healing

Through a FEMA grant and the NJ Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services, <u>NJ Hope & Healing</u> provides mental health support to those struggling mentally and emotionally with the COVID-19 pandemic. COVID-19 Related Blood Shortages

Healthcare centers nationwide have been experiencing blood donation shortages. In particular, the <u>American Red Cross</u> has a constant need for blood and platelet donations. With the ongoing pandemic, the Red Cross needs the help of blood and platelet donors and blood drives to meet the needs of patient care. The Red Cross follows the highest standard of safety and infection control and volunteer blood donations are the only source for those in need. Hospitals have resumed surgical procedures and patient treatments that were temporarily paused due to the pandemic. <u>Learn more here</u>.

Even if you tested positive for COVID-19 or received a COVID-19 vaccine, you can still donate blood. If you received a vaccine you will need to know the manufacturer name when you donate. In most cases there is no deferral time for individuals who have received a vaccine as long as they are feeling well at the time of donation. There is a deferral time of 14 days for those who test positive for COVID-19 or show compatible symptoms.

FDA Approval for the Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine: Spikevax

On Jan 31, 2022 the <u>FDA announced</u> the second approval of a COVID-19 vaccine in addition Pfizer-BioNTech 's Comirnaty mRNA vaccine. Moderna's COVID-19 vaccine will now be marketed as "Spikevax" for the prevention of COVID-19 in individuals 18 years of age and older.

Spikevax contains the same formula as the EUA Moderna COVID-19 vaccine and is administered as a primary series of two doses, 28 days apart. It has also been approved as a third primary series dose (third dose) for immunocompromised individuals over the age of 18 and as a single booster dose for those over the age of 18 at least 5 months after completing their primary series. Spikevax can be used interchangeably with the EUA Moderna COVID-19 vaccine.

The Moderna COVID-19 vaccine is also authorized for use as a heterologous (mix and match) single booster for those over the age of 18 following completion of a primary series with a different available COVID-19 vaccine. For example, Pfizer and J&J vaccine recipients would be able to receive a single booster dose of the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine.
