Camp Rules/Code of Conduct

Please review the following information with your child. The three pillars of the Mendham Day Camp remind campers to **be respectful, stay together, and be safe**. All campers are expected to follow these general rules:

- No use of cell phones or electronic devices during camp hours.
- Campers must follow all guidelines and instructions provided by counselors, head staff, or the Directors.
- All injuries or incidents must be reported to a counselor immediately.
- Campers must remain with their groups at all times, unless given specific permission by their counselor.
- Campers are entitled to have a camp experience free of hazing, bullying, or similar behavioral issues.
- No foul language will be tolerated. This includes making inappropriate or disrespectful comments and using offensive language.
- No using or possession of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products.
- No weapons (or objects which look like any weapon) of any kind are permitted.
- No violence, or threat of violence, against any person at the Mendham Day Camp will be tolerated.
- Campers shall not steal, damage, or deface the property of other campers, counselors, or the Borough.
- Campers must not act recklessly or engage in behavior that endangers themselves or others. Any behavior deemed a threat to the safety and well-being of the camp will not be tolerated.

Discipline Policies

The Mendham Day Camp seeks to provide a safe and fun environment for all campers and counselors. In the event that any of the rules are broken, disciplinary policies are in place and will be implemented at the discretion of the Camp Director.

Discipline policies include, but are not limited to:

- Verbal warning.
- Restriction from activities in the Carriage House.

- Conference with the Camp Director and/or Recreation Coordinator.
- Written incident report.
- Early pick-up by parent/guardian.
- Suspension from Mendham Day Camp.
- Removal from Mendham Day Camp.

*Refunds will **not** be issued for campers who have been removed from camp due to disciplinary issues.*

Please note: Camp Directors, in consultation with the Recreation Coordinator, reserve the right to deny future camp registration to any camper based on past disciplinary actions or violations of camp rules.
