Mayor's Update

Dear Resident and Business Owners,

It's that colorful time of the year again when our town glows with our trees full of autumn colors. To start your fall off right you need look no further than our garden triangle at Cold Hill Road where our Garden Club has set up a lovely fall display. Thank you Garden Club for making our town look ready for the season.

Updates on Main Street:

Dunkin Donuts

The rumor mill has been buzzing and wondering what is going on with the Dunkin Donuts development site. I have been staying in touch regularly with the owners of that space and have the latest. The demolition and excavation work was progressing along until they found that the water table was higher than first estimated during the testing phase. They confirmed for me that there is no well and Morris County has not taken over this site.

Our developer's technical engineer initiated a 45 day water flow study to help determine any modifications that would be required. Once they had the information on the water flow and level their team performed some reengineering to their plan including the foundation and storm water plan.

With a completed approved plan the project will restart within the next month and as soon as they can get the contractor back on the job.

Black Horse Inn and Pub

The Pub is getting ready to start its next round of improvements. The overall exterior plan was approved before the pandemic which has added delays with all projects. The next step will have their crew replacing the exterior of the Pub building with a historically approved material.

I know some of you have noticed that over at the Inn

the front porch is being supported by a metal column. The Black Horse tells me that they had noticed an increased sagging in the porch and were immediately advised by their engineer to shore it up. Their engineer is currently working on a more permanent solution they plan to implement early next year.

Come out and join us Saturday, October 2nd for our Food Truck Festival, sponsored by our Mendham Borough Recreation Committee. There will be plenty of tasty food options. The Library has been busy. So far this year, we have offered some 240 programs for children and adults, with a total attendance of over 3,700. Circulation has reached new levels in 2021, as residents have increasingly taken advantage of our virtual offerings like Hoopla and Cloud Library. Two programs which we started because of the pandemic, Curbside Crafts for Kids, and Jigsaw Puzzle Exchange (which stopped for the summer, but will return in November) have met with great success.
