Great news! We were approved for a Morris County Historic Preservation grant for the Scott Farm barn restoration project. We want to thank the Morris County Commissioners, as well as the Morris County Preservation Trust Fund Review Board. The Borough received \$40,680 which will be used for the design and construction document process of the project. We will be applying for additional grants to help us complete the restoration phase of the project. Once completed we look forward to the Scott barn being used by local groups and for farming demonstrations.

In the interim, if you have not been to the Scott Farm barn area, please join me and our neighbor, the Director of Communication for the Audubon Society of New Jersey, Chris Neff, for a "Walk and Talk" of the property. Chris and I will be meeting up with residents on Sunday, September 18 at 10 a.m. at the property on Mountainside Road for a tour of the area and discussion of local wildlife species. 
