



The Municipal Stormwater Management Plan (MSWMP)

- Per NJDEP MSWMP permit requires municipalities to update their plans on a decennial basis every ten years.
- The MSWMP is a planning document is required to be adopted as part of Borough Master Plan by the municipalities Land Use Board.
- Municipalities updates of the MSWMP are pending the NJDEP adoption of rules revisions to the MSWMP requirements and pending the State adoption of the NJPACT/REAL climate change rules.
- NJDEP adoption of rules revisions is anticipated to be completed in 2026.
- The cost to Municipalities to update their plans prior to State adoption of the NJPACT/REAL rules and then must do their plan again after State adoption of the NJPACT/REAL is cost prohibitive.
