HOMETOWN HEROES BANNER PROGRAM

APPLICATION

BANNER ELIGIBILITY

- Any active or reserve member of the U.S. the U.S. Military who lives or lived in the Borough.
- Any U.S. Military Veteran, living or deceased, and honorably discharged, who lives or lived in the Borough.

BANNER INFORMATION

- Banners display the service member's photo in uniform, name, rank, conflict, years of service and major military awards, such as the Medal of Honor, Navy Cross, Silver Star, Bronze Star and Purple Heart.
- Initial preference given to older living veterans of WWI, WWII, and the Korean and Vietnam Wars.
- Banners are installed along East and West Main Street for two weeks in conjunction with the Memorial Day and Veterans' Day holidays.
- The number of banners produced each year will be determined by the Hometown Heroes Banner Program Committee and sponsorship donations.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

- April 1st for the Current Year's Program.
