A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MENDHAM, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 RATIFYING THE AWARD OF AN EMERGENCY CONTRACT WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING AS AN EXCEPTION TO THE BIDDING STATUTES

WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen at the Mendham Borough Sewer Plant wherein the main force main into the plant has failed and must be repaired immediately; and

WHEREAS, an apparent hydraulic restriction was recently discovered in the main force main at the Borough Sewer Plant which carries all sewage materials into the Sewer Plant; and

WHEREAS, this restriction creates an emergency situation as the main force main as no materials can be processed due to the blockage, creating an actual and imminent danger to public health, safety, welfare and sanitation; and

WHEREAS, the Sewer Plant Engineer has advised the Borough through the Chair of the Public Works/Utilities Committee that, as a matter of public health, safety and welfare, there is an emergent need to repair the main force main; and

WHEREAS, this blockage was not a reasonably foreseeable occurrence; and

WHEREAS, quotations will be sought from companies qualified to perform the emergency repairs to the main force main according to the Sewer Plant Engineer's specifications; and

WHEREAS, the contract will be awarded to the company that provides the most responsive and responsible quote for the immediate repair of the main force main and which meets the State of New Jersey contractual requirements to perform work in the Borough of Mendham; and

WHEREAS, the contract for emergency work shall be in an amount not exceed \$120,000; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Finance Officer has identified an appropriate capital ordinance in which adequate funds are available to certify and encumber the funds for said purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mendham, County of Morris and State of New Jersey, that the Borough Sewer Plant Engineer and Borough Administrator are authorized to solicits quotations and award a contract without competitive bidding to a qualified company for the emergency repair of the main force main at the Mendham Borough Sewer Plant in an amount not to exceed \$120,000; and

WHEREAS, the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12b permits a public body to go into a closed session during a public meeting to discuss certain matters as follows:

- (1) Matters required by law to be confidential: Any matter which by express provision of the Federal law or State statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act.
- (2) Any matter in which the release of information would impair the right to receive federal funding.
- (3) Matters involving individual privacy: Any matter, the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as records, data, reports, recommendations or other personal material of any education, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including, but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal and family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless the individual concerned.
- (4) Matters pertaining to a collective bargaining agreement: Any matter involving a collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body.
- (5) Matters relating to the purchase, lease, acquisition of real property or investment of public funds: Any matter involving the lease, purchase or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed.
- (6) Matters of public protection: Any tactic and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public, provided that their disclosure could impair such protection.
- (7) Matters relating to litigation, negotiations and attorney-client privilege: Any matter of pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation other than in (4) above in which the Borough is or may become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required for the attorney to exercise ethical duties as a lawyer.
- (8) Matters relating to the employment relationship: Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance of, promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all of the individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed in public.
- (9) Deliberations after public hearing. Deliberations by the Borough occurring after a public hearing that may result in a civil penalty or the suspension or loss of a license or permit of a responding party; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has determined that it is necessary to go into a closed session to discuss certain matters relating to items as permitted by N.J.S.A. 10:4-12b.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mendham that it will go into closed session to discuss the following, in accordance with the aforesaid provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act, after which it will reconvene in the open public session:

1. Matters of public protection – N.J.S.A 10:4-12b(6)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the minutes of the closed session will be made available to the public when the need for privacy no longer exists.

ORDINANCE 03-2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MENDHAM TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Borough of Mendham in the County of Morris finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2018 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the governing body hereby determines that a 1.0% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$61,470.54 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the governing body hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the governing body of the Borough of Mendham, in the County of Morris, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2018 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Mendham shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$215,146.88, and that the CY 2018 municipal budget for the Borough of Mendham be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.
