**RESOLUTION #78-2025**

**RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR EMERGENCY TEMPORARY  
APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE 2025 SEWER FUND BUDGET**

**WHEREAS**, the official budget for calendar year 2025 will be adopted on April 09, 2025 and provisions need to be made for the 2025 Sewer Fund Budget appropriations for expenditures between March 24<sup>th</sup> and April 9<sup>th</sup> and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-20 provides for the creation of an emergency temporary appropriation for the purposes herein; and

**WHEREAS**, the adopted 2025 Temporary Sewer Fund Budget amount is \$454,259.00 and the emergency appropriation is \$17,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the amended 2025 Temporary Sewer Fund Budget total is \$471,259.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the emergency temporary appropriations by account are as follows; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Borough of Mendham, Morris County, New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of all the members therefore affirmatively concurring) as follows:

1. The emergency temporary appropriations shall be adopted into the 2025 Temporary Sewer Fund Budget in the amount of \$17,000.00.
2. That amended total Temporary Sewer Fund Budget shall be \$471,259.00.
3. The Deputy Borough Clerk shall file one (1) certified copy of this resolution with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services and with the Borough's Chief Financial Officer.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that all other Borough officials and employees are hereby authorized to take all action necessary and appropriate to effectuate the terms of this Resolution.

This resolution shall take effect immediately.
