WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:5-45, the resolution "shall specify those types of charges, taxes, fees, assessments, fines, or other obligations approved for card based or electronic funds transfer payment, except that credit card payment shall not be authorized for the payment of delinquent local unit obligations or for the redemption of local unit liens"; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mendham have determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough's taxpayers, residents and visitors for the Borough to permit electronic funds transfer payments through the Borough's official website for real estate taxes, utility bills, licenses, permits, and fees.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Mendham, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. Real estate taxes, utility bills, licenses, permits, and fees are hereby authorized to be paid by use of electronic funds transfer through the Borough's official website.
- 2. The Administration is authorized to take such action as is necessary to implement the payment procedures.
- 3. A certified copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
- 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

WHEREAS, Jeanne Pugsley, Administrative Assistant to the Borough Administrator, has agreed to process such requests; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Administrator and Borough Attorney will assist Ms. Pugsley with such requests as needed.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mendham that Jeanne Pugsley is hereby designated a deputy custodian of records and is authorized to process Open Public Records Act requests submitted to the Borough in the Borough Clerk's absence, with the assistance of the Administrator and Borough Attorney as needed.
