On behalf of the Mendham Economic Development Committee, Mr. Neil Sullivan, chair, reported that the committee is interested in establishing a Mendham Museum. The committee will be speaking with the Audi dealership on Main Street who own the former TD Bank property across the street from their business as a potential location for the museum. Once established, the museum would be staffed by volunteers and would showcase artifacts and photos of the borough's history. It is anticipated that the museum would be open to the community one or two days a week.
