## **ORDINANCE #15-2021**

## ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MENDHAM, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 102, FEES, § 102.1, SCHEDULE OF FEES, TO INCORPORATE OUTDOOR DINING PERMIT FEES

WHEREAS, on October 13, 2021, the Mayor and Borough Council adopted Ordinance #13-2021, amending Chapter 215, Zoning, of the Borough Code to establish an outdoor dining ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance #13-2021 set forth fees for outdoor dining permits; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council now desires to amend Chapter 102, Fees, of the Borough Code to reflect the new outdoor dining permit fees.

**THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mendham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 102, Fees, § 102.1, Schedule of Fees, Chapter 215, Zoning, is hereby amended to add the following language:

| "§ 215-68 | Outdoor Dining Permit Fee |

| 1-12 seats, no more than 2 tables | \$100 |
|-----------------------------------|-------|
| 13-25 seats                       | \$250 |
| 26-50 seats                       | \$350 |
| Over 50 seats                     | \$450 |

The renewal permit fee shall be the same as above, except that it shall be reduced to 25% of the initial permit fee where there is no change in ownership or expansion of outdoor dining seating from the previous year's permit.

**SECTION 2.** All ordinances of the Borough of Mendham that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 3**. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.
