#### #13-2021 ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MENDHAM, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING THE BOROUGH CODE TO PERMIT OUTDOOR DINING AND OUTDOOR SEATING TO FACILITATE SMALL BUSINESS RECOVERY NEEDED IN LIGHT OF THE COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

Purpose: Recent changes in the economy, including a public health emergency and resulting social distancing requirements, have led the Borough's Finance Committee to review outdoor dining requirements. The Governing Body desires to enable local restaurants and food and beverage service establishments, with appropriate guidelines, to serve customers and encourage social distancing requirements. Outdoor dining and outdoor seating can accommodate the Borough's long-term Master Plan vision of protecting the small-town character of the community, while also helping to maintain a healthy business district.

Legal Notice Statement: A legal notice was published indicating that Ordinance #13-2021 was introduced and passed on first reading at the September 9, 2021 meeting and further indicated that the second reading and public hearing would be held on October 13, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. Copies of this Ordinance were made available to the public and posted in accordance with the law.

# #14-2021 ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MENDHAM, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 187, STREET NAMES, OF THE BOROUGH CODE TO UPDATE STREET INFORMATION
