HC 14-10: M. Navarro & J. Griffault – Review of Sign

Applicant had provided the Commission with sign design and materials with their application dated July 31, 2010.

Mr. Griffault explained that they are planning a holistic healing center with two work spaces and a general area. They will have individual clients as well as 6 to 8 people in mediation classes. They are proposing two signs. There is a street sign that will be placed in the space directly above the existing sign on the post. It will be white vinyl laminate. They are also replacing the existing striped awning with a simple black awning above the steps with the log and name of the company. The awning color will match the street sign. The logo will be green.

Mr. Cusano explained that the Commission prefers and approves wooden signs. The name and logo can be painted on the sign. The design is acceptable. Applicant agreed that they would make the change.

Mr. Cusano made a motion to approve the sign as submitted, but with the utilization of wood as opposed to the vinyl laminate presented in the application. Ms. Carpenter seconded.
