7. ADMINISTRATOR OPERATIONS REPORT

Administrator Bushman reported that the Highlands Plan is moving forward. The Borough is very excited about the upcoming Mendham Fest on October 4th.

8. COUNCIL REPORTS

Recreation and Parks/School Boards Liaison – Chair Matthew Bruin –

The Chair announced that Mendham Fest and The Harvest Hustle will be held on Saturday, October 4th. There will also be s'mores, a firepit, and family games at Botti Field on Thursday, October 24th.

Public Works & Utilities-Chair Bruce LaFera

The Chair reported that the WRF Department's permit renewal application will be submitted on October 3rd. The DPW has installed electronic locks at the Botti Pavilion, and the bathrooms at Patriots Path are now open.

Land Use - Chair Alexandra Henry Traut

JLUB approved an application for an addition on Prospect Street. The Chair reminded residents of the sign ordinance, emphasizing that with the upcoming election, signs should not be placed in the public right-of-way. She also shared that she attended the Morris County League of Municipalities quarterly meeting and inquired whether the Council would be interested in designating the Borough as a veteran-friendly municipality.

Finance Committee- Neil Sullivan

The Chair stated that he met with the Mayor and the former Finance Chair to review the budget process in order to better familiarize himself with it.

Personnel Committee/ Volunteer Projects Liaison- Will Russo

The Chair reported that the new Tax Collector has started and expressed that the Borough is fortunate to have her. She also noted that the Borough is making tremendous strides in personnel.

9. MAYOR'S ITEMS

A meeting is added for December 10th. The December 17th meeting will be held only if needed. The Reorganization meeting is being rescheduled from January 2nd to Wednesday, January 7th.

10. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Russ Pagana of 1 Franklin Road spoke regarding Ordinance 206-49, requesting that the gate to the school be closed at 3:30 p.m. Captain McNichol noted that it is currently

scheduled to close at 5 p.m., but Mr. Pagana requested an earlier closure because UPS and Amazon drivers are using the area as a cut-through, and he is concerned for his young grandchildren who play in front of his house.

Margaret Burke of 8 Bockoven Road expressed concerns about congestion issues throughout the Borough and requested that another traffic study be conducted. She also asked for the bathrooms at the Carriage House and Botti Field to be unlocked, and noted that the benches around the fire pit at the Mud Hole need to be removed due to deterioration.
