RESOLUTION #059-2026

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF CONTRACT WITH BLUE DIAMOND DISPOSAL, INC. FOR COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS AND BULK SOLID WASTE (TYPE 13) FROM APRIL 1, 2026 THROUGH MAY 31, 2026

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., and pursuant to Resolution 37-2021, adopted on January 13, 2021, the Borough of Mendham awarded a five-year contract to Blue Diamond Disposal, Inc. (“Blue Diamond”) for the collection of recyclable materials and bulk solid waste (Type 13), with the contract ending on January 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, by way of Resolution #041-2026 adopted on January 21, 2026, the Borough and Blue Diamond extended Blue Diamond’s contract from February 1, 2026 through March 31, 2026 to allow additional time for the Borough to reject the bids received and rebid the services; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to again extend the contract with Blue Diamond for two months, from April 1, 2026 through May 31, 2026, in an amount not to exceed the current rate of \$24,275 per month for recycling and bulk waste, while the Borough completes the bid process, with bids to be opened on March 31, 2026, to procure these services; and

WHEREAS, per correspondence dated February 18, 2020, Blue Diamond has agreed to the proposed contract extension; and

WHEREAS, the Borough’s Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available for these contract extensions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mendham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Borough hereby extends the contract with Blue Diamond Disposal, Inc. for the curbside collection of recycling material and bulk waste for the current contract price not to exceed \$24,275 per month, for the period of April 1, 2026 through May 31, 2026.
2. The Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract.
3. This Resolution and contract shall be available for public inspection in the office of the Borough Clerk.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
