RESOLUTION #082-2026

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION BY THE BOROUGH OF MENDHAM TO THE NEW JERSEY HISTORIC TRUST 2026 PRESERVE NEW JERSEY HISTORIC PRESERVATION FUND CONSTRUCTION AND REHABILITATION GRANT FOR PHASE III IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CARY BARN OWNED BY THE BOROUGH OF MENDHAM

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mendham ("Borough") is the owner of the c.1825 Cary Barn located at 88 Mountainside Road in Mendham Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has been offered the opportunity to apply for a 2026 Grant from Preserve New Jersey Historic Preservation Fund grant program administered by the New Jersey Historic Trust; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's grant application must be signed by an authorized representative of the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Mendham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Borough hereby authorizes the submission of an application to the Preserve New Jersey Historic Preservation Fund for a 2026 Construction and Rehabilitation Grant for improvements to the Cary Barn.
2. The Borough hereby authorizes Mayor James Kelly, or his authorized designee, to execute the assurances.
3. The Borough will be requesting \$428,900.00 through the grant application, and the Borough will match the requested amount with an anticipated \$428,900.00 through a 2026 grant application to the Morris County Historic Preservation Trust Fund and will be used in accordance with grant rules and regulations for a total project estimated to be \$857,800.00.
4. This resolution shall be submitted as part of the 2026 grant application package submittal to the Preserve New Jersey Historic Preservation Fund.
5. The Mayor, the Borough Clerk, together with all other appropriate officers, employees, professionals and staff of the Borough are hereby authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to effectuate the purpose of this resolution.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
