**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH TO REQUEST AN INTRERLOCAL  
AGREEMENT PROPOSAL WITH THE COUNTY OF MORRIS FOR SHARED COSTS  
PROGRAM FOR THE THREE-YEAR EAST MAIN STREET, WEST MAIN STREET (CR  
510), HILLTOP ROAD (CR 525), AND MOUNTAIN AVENUE TRAFFIC SIGNAL  
REPLACEMENT PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Mendham Police Department and Council Public Safety Committee have recommended that the Borough Council request a interlocal services agreement proposal for review between the Borough and the County of Morris for funding of the three-year East Main Street, West Main Street (CR 510), Hilltop Road (CR 525), and Mountain Avenue Traffic Signal Replacement Project (the "Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, under the agreement proposal for review the County Program will provide seventy percent (70%) of the net final cost for the Project based on signal replacement plans completed for the County and according to a cost schedule appended to the agreement, and the Borough of Mendham will pay approximately thirty percent (30%) of the total, as provided in the agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council desire to authorize the Borough to request an interlocal services agreement proposal for review, in a form approved by the Borough Attorney, between the County of Morris and the Borough of Mendham for shared funding of the Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Borough of Mendham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Borough is hereby authorized and directed to request an Interlocal Services Agreement proposal from the County of Morris, for the three-year East Main Street, West Main Street (CR 510), Hilltop Road (CR 525), and Mountain Avenue Signal Replacement Project, in a form approved by the Borough Attorney.
2. Borough officials and employees are hereby authorized and directed to take all action necessary and appropriate to effectuate this request for an Interlocal Services Agreement proposal to be provided by the County.
3. A copy of this Resolution shall be kept on file in of the office of the Borough Clerk for inspection by the public.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
