**RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF MENDHAM, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF
NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A
FLASHING PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK SIGN ON HILLTOP ROAD AT HILLTOP SCHOOL**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mendham desires to install a pedestrian-activated 24/7 flashing LED pedestrian crosswalk sign on Hilltop Road at Hilltop School, which is a County road, to improve public safety; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the flashing LED pedestrian crosswalk sign is \$10,002.70; and

WHEREAS, the Mendham Borough School District received a School Safety Grant for \$3,400.00 for the purchase of the sign; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has allocated \$4,679.32 from the Parking Offense Adjudication Act (POAA) fund and the estimated remaining amount of \$1,923.38 from the Police Department Traffic Signage Account; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mendham will install the sign and be responsible for ongoing maintenance and replacement costs related to the sign.

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Committee has reviewed and recommends the approval of this resolution; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mendham, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The installation of pedestrian-activated 24/7 flashing LED pedestrian crosswalk signs Hilltop Road by the Borough of Mendham is hereby authorized.
2. The Borough of Mendham shall be responsible for sign maintenance and replacement costs after installation.
