- 3. Patrolman Gibson's salary shall commence at Step 2 at \$65,738, in accordance with the Collective Bargaining Agreement for a Probationary period of six months beginning March 10, 2021 and ending on September 10, 2021.
- 4. At the end of the Probationary period, Patrolman Gibson's salary will be adjusted to Step 3 at \$71,450, also in accordance with the Collective Bargaining Agreement, and shall be pro-rated for the remainder of the calendar year.
- 5. The Mayor, the Borough Clerk, together with all other appropriate officers, employees, professionals, and staff of the Borough are hereby authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to effectuate the purpose of this resolution.
